

CAMPGROUND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Are there powered sites available?

No and access to power is not available in the campground however patrons are welcome to bring generators.

Can I bring a caravan?

Yes, as long as it fits with your purchased site

How many people can I have on a Site?

As many as will fit, along with your vehicle – it is recommended no more than 4 people be accommodated per site

How big are the sites?

Approx 10m x 8m

How much are the campsites?

\$60 per site in purchased in advance of the Event and \$70 if purchased at the Event (prices refer to duration of the Event, regardless of whether you stay 1 night or 4)

Where do I get tickets from?

Ticketek – 13 28 49 or at the Gate (adjacent to Harris Park and Campground Staff will have tickets available for sale)

Can I buy tickets on the day?

Yes

When do campgrounds open and close?

Paddock opens 9am Thursday 23 February and closes 9am Monday 27 February 2012

Can we arrive early?

No. Patrons will only be permitted to camp from the Thursday pre Event due to insurance and OH@S considerations

Can I bring a motorbike/scooter?

Yes, provided it is road registered

Is alcohol allowed in the Campground?

Yes, as long as it is not in glass bottles

Is the Top of the Mountain open?

Not for camping, however patrons can drive their vehicles to the Top of the Mountain during racing hours

Can I buy food at the Venue?

Yes, there are food vans and concessions at the Event

Am I allowed behind the Paddock/Pit Area?

Yes, and this Event does not have a Paddock pass therefore all ticketed patrons have unrestricted access to the Paddock (not the Pit Complex) behind the Pit Area

Can I take petrol into the campground?

Yes, however a maximum of 5 litres is permitted to be stored in containers within the campgrounds

Can I light a campfire?

Yes, provided no fire restrictions are in place and you keep the fire contained with your site and controlled

Are there amenities?

Yes, each campground has the sufficient amenities (toilets and showers for male and females)

Is there security in the campgrounds?

Yes, there will be Event security patrolling campgrounds however the Event takes no responsibility for Camper's belongings

How do I access the Circuit and Campgrounds?

Only the Main Gate on Mount Panorama Drive will be operational

Where do I park my car?

Patrons must park their car within their allocated campsite, otherwise an additional site must be purchased or the car parked in the general car park outside the Main Gate

Will my car be secure?

We take no responsibility for theft or damage, however the general car park is lit and security personnel roam the area

Is there a shuttle bus running from the bottom of the Mountain to the Top?

Yes, from Harris Park during Racing for \$5 return trip

What are the conditions of entry?

- You must comply with the terms and conditions appearing on your entry ticket
- You must comply with all signs, instructions and directions regulating this event
- You must comply with all directions from the Police, Security and Officials
- No glass bottles are not permitted into the Event Venue
- No illegal substances are permitted into the Event Venue
- No fireworks or explosives are permitted into the Event Venue
- No weapons are permitted into the Event Venue
- No petrol canisters over a 5 litre capacity are permitted into the Event Venue
- No animals are permitted into the Event Venue
- No platforms or anything that can be used to erect platforms is permitted into the Event Venue. Nothing that will obstruct the view of patrons is allowed to be constructed.
- Failure to comply with these conditions may result in refusal of entry to or removal from the Event Venue
- The Event Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, damage, claim or demand suffered by any person(s) as a result (directly or indirectly) of non-compliance with these campground conditions of entry.

What are the Campground Rules

- Reasonable behaviour is expected at all times. The police and/or security will enforce eviction for disorderly conduct and other misbehaviour.
- The Event Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to the Campgrounds to any person it deems unfit or inappropriate in its discretion.
- If your vehicle and/or accommodation facilities exceed the campsite size you are required to purchase an additional site. A tow away service will be in operation for any vehicles that are not parked completely within the allotted campsite.
- Unregistered or un-roadworthy vehicles will not be admitted into the campground area.
- Private vehicles may only be used for entering and exiting the campgrounds and circuit. Use of vehicles within the Campgrounds for unlawful/dangerous practices is strictly forbidden.
- Identification vehicle passes issued by the Event Organiser must be affixed to the vehicle and clearly visible.
- All requests and directions regarding the above from the Event Organiser, security and/or police must be adhered to at all times.
- The Event Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, damage, claim or demand suffered by any person(s) as a result (directly or indirectly) of non-compliance with these campground rules.
